

Phase 1 Invite Your DOM to Preach

- Sunday Morning
- Target Time Frame: 1-3 months ahead of any church revitalization effort.

Phase 2 Private Pastoral Consultation

- Confidential
- BATCH & SWOT Analysis
- Determine where you want to go and how to get there.


Phase 3 Strategic Planning with Key Leaders

- Address only one area at first.
- STEP Analysis & SWOT Analysis
- Determine key metrics.
- Develop effective strategies, systems, and structures for ministries.

Phase 4 Implementation & Evaluation

- Put people and procedures in place.
- Follow up with leaders and volunteers.
- SWOT Analysis & Key Metrics Review
- Make necessary adjustments.

"WHATEVER YOUR HAND FINDS TO DO, DO IT WITH YOUR MIGHT" ECCLESIASTES 9:10

ED GOODMAN - DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS

I have always been afraid of heights. The first time I ever used a ladder as a young boy revealed this fear but also taught me a valuable lesson. After knocking a whiffle ball onto the roof of my house, I began a treacherous climb to retrieve it. After just a few steps up, I became skittish about falling. However, in order for the baseball game to continue, I needed to get the ball out of the gutter. So I made a defining decision to ignore the ground altogether and just focus on taking the next step up the ladder. It worked. In a matter of seconds, the ball was retrieved and the game continued. Not only did I conquer my fear (at least for the moment), but I also accomplished my mission - all by remaining focused on the next step.

As we enter a new year, our churches have an opportunity to take another step up the ladder of ministry effectiveness. After a banner year that included 54 baptisms, the launch of a Christian school, increased giving, and the hire of a new associational staff member, we certainly have a lot to celebrate going into 2019! In light of these ministry markers, it may be tempting to scratch our heads and wonder where we go from here. Let me offer a few suggestions for how each church in our association can take the next step in ministry this year.

Define Your Purpose

What is the mission of your church? Is your mission clearly communicated and understood by the people? Could your church benefit from some tools to help you better define your reason for existence?

In 2019, bring your church's purpose into laser-sharp focus: Ask your associational staff to partner with you in establishing this essential element of effective ministry. We are ready to serve YOU because YOU are the church and YOU are the reason we exist!

Determine Your Priorities

Why is your church involved in certain ministries? What drives your engagement in ministry? Ministry is about knowing what to do as well as knowing what not to do. Discerning your church's values will provide the bridge that legitimately links your mission to your strategy. After all, the why is one of the key driving factors of Gospel ministry. Effective church leaders recognize their responsibility to prioritize ministries that reflect biblical, mission-driven values. Your associational staff can provide tools and personal assistance as you seek to determine what motivates your people.

Develop Your Plan

How will your church accomplish its mission? Are your church's systems, structure, and staff aligned with its purpose? A church without a strategy is like a rifle without a scope – you're very unlikely to hit your target. The good news is that your associational staff is equipped and eager to help you polish the plans that will engage your community and enrich your church. Don't start the year without a ministry strategy in place – let your associational staff lend a hand.

The UOVBA can connect your church to potential funding for church revitalization efforts or to mission teams seeking to serve local congregations. 


